INITIATIVES ON GREEN CAMPUS

Dhanalakshmi Srinivasan College of Engineering and Technology (DSCET) have implemented the green campus measures as per the Environmental Policy in the campus to promote the environmental protection and sustainable development. The following initiatives and measures are established and expanded periodically for the promotion of green campus

1. Restricted entry of vehicles

- Entry of all the vehicles including two wheelers and four wheelers belonging to the students, teachers, administrators, parents and other staff are restricted before entering college campus and should be parked in the parking area allotted at the vertices of the campus.

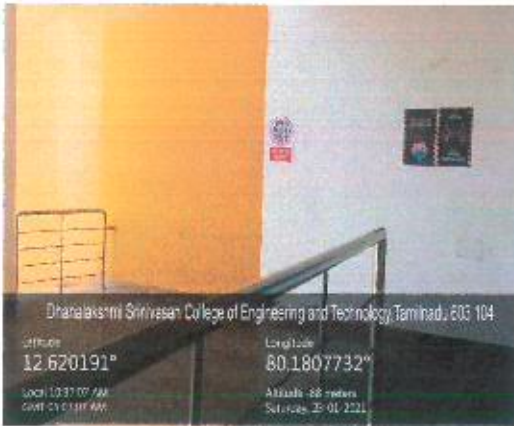

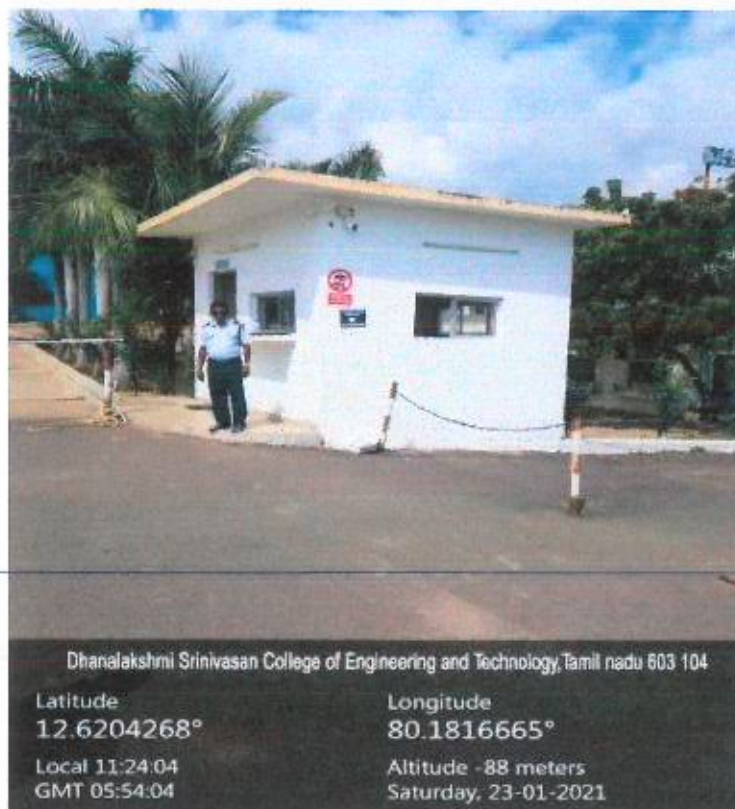

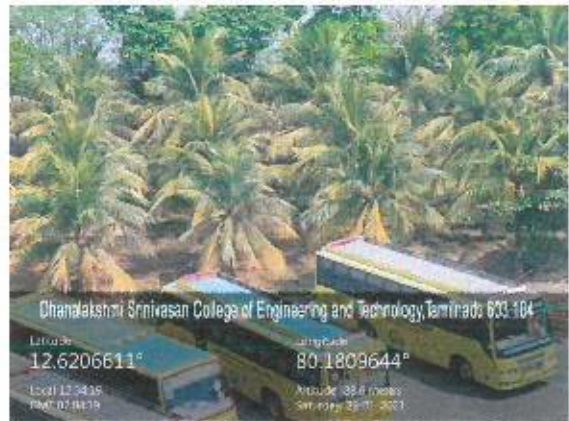
